We will be creating and discussing this year's budget which we will then send out for a vote to members



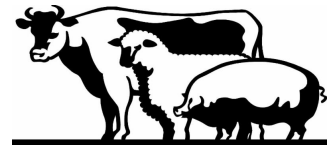
### **Wednesday, October 4 - Scholarship Committee Meeting**
